6th Grade Summer Book Report

Hello incoming 6th graders! Happy summer! I hope you are enjoying your summer break! I love that summer is a slower pace and I always find time to do more things. Something I really love is more time to READ! I encourage you to find time to read.... outside, by the pool, on a road trip or at home in your favorite reading spot. My favorite spot is on the deck, with a snack. $\stackrel{\square}{\cup}$

As you read your book, you will be completing a <u>One-Pager</u>. A one pager is a way to visually share what you have learned. When you create a one pager, you are trying to use both visual symbols and important words to clearly share your most important takeaways.

I have provided a template that demonstrates where things should be included and a blank template for you to print and complete.

Here's what your one pager MUST INCLUDE:

- A border which represents 2 key themes and 2 important quotes from the story
- An important symbol from the story and a quote woven around it (upper left hand corner)
- Images or doodled words that represent key characters from the novel (upper right hand
- Images or doodled words that represent at least 1 major setting from the story (lower left hand corner)
- Images and/or words that show a connection between the theme(s) in the novel and what is going on in the world (lower left hand corner)

You may also add other symbols, drawing and words that represent the reading.
